

UPDATE ON HARDYS BAY MEN'S SHED

Since the concept of a men's shed was initially raised by Cathy Baker of Killy Cares and a substantial amount of investigation done by Stephen Hinks in late 2020, huge advances have been made in bringing this idea to fruition. Thanks to the tireless work of Ted Harnett, Simon Lewer, Brian Plain and Stephen Hinks, Hardys Bay Men's Shed should be, under normal circumstances, now operational.

Following the decision to use the building at the rear of Hardys Bay Community Church, the Central Coast Council was approached and permission given via email that, provided the Men's Shed was under the umbrella of the church, the building could be used. From this point many hours of work were put in by a lot of individuals to not only renovate the shed, comply with all the necessary government requirements but to also organise a very successful fundraising dinner in June 2021 at which a substantial amount of money was raised through both donations and the direct purchase of tools for the shed.

The event was widely advertised in the area, and this, along with a letterbox drop to the adjacent neighbours at the beginning of the year, ensured that, in the opinion of the committee, everyone was aware of and in agreement with the venture. As there appeared to be no objections and funds were now available, the committee proceeded with the plan. After holding our first meeting of interested men from the area, we were advised that written objections had been lodged with council. We are currently in discussion with Council to determine whether we are required to submit a Development Application for the venture or not. This coupled with the Covid 19 pandemic restrictions have prevented the shed being anywhere near opening at a time when it is needed by local men more than ever.
