President's Notes

As the warmer weather approaches we all look forward to being out and about in the bush, beach and bay settings that we so enjoy. Part of the enjoyment we have needs to be tempered with appropriate care for the environment on the one hand and protection from its hazards on the other. We are all encouraged to attend the various community events hosted by Killcare RFS and by Killcare SLSC which are designed to inform us of various safety measures we can take personally and of the emergency services available to us in the event of assistance being required.

One of the most critical aspects of any emergency alert and response is reliable telecommunications. Mobile service reception in the Bouddi Peninsula is between patchy and non-existent both indoors and outdoors. While many of us resort to wifi calling in the home, this in itself requires stable NBN service. If you are out and about, NBN is of no help. WTKCA has been calling for improved mobile communications in our area for a long time, and the proposed solution based on a tower on Council land on Wards Hill Road seemed to meet all the requirements. This proposal was approved by Council and by the Land and Environment Court some time ago, and the telcos are keen to get it installed and operational. Unfortunately the various approvals are currently subject to a challenge in the courts raised by an objector, with no clear timeframe for resolution.

WTKCA maintains contact with the telco proponents to reinforce the community need for improved mobile services. We have also stressed this with our State MP Adam Crouch and our Federal MP Gordon Reid with calls for assistance in getting this resolved, respecting of course the processes of the courts. You might care to do the same.

We have also asked Gordon Reid MP to follow through our earlier requests for NBN Co to upgrade the capacity and reliability of fixed line services in our area. If you run a business at home or plug in to your company systems from home you have no doubt experienced the frustrations of drop-outs and slow line speeds. Then there is the little matter of increased summer demand for streamed video over this creaking network.

Let's hope for some attention to this crucial service asap.
