WTKCA would like to thank all those involved in the process and looks forward to making use of these new capabilities in community and private events in the near future.

In the meantime we can all be thankful for the great weather we have been enjoying on those occasions we get out for our 2 person exercise. Plus dogs of course – very happy. Remember to wave and say hi to the neighbours on your way past too.
