Artists and artisans will open their studios and workshops on 1 and 2 October from 9.00am.

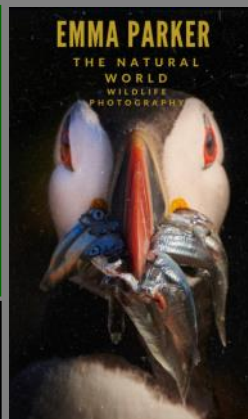
