

President's Notes

So, the Ettalong Channel is silted up again and the Palm Beach ferry is diverted to Patonga. This is due to the abject failure of Transport NSW to meet their obligations in their Coastal Dredging Strategy for regular minor maintenance to the channel profile. They have known for over 12 months that some trimming was needed and never progressed the basic selection of operators to do the job. Not only the ferries, but any deep draft vessel is now compromised on safety until this is fixed.

Fantasea have a standard diversion timetable used in times of major storm events etc, but this time the diversion is longer term. How do you get to and from Patonga other than driving 40 minutes from Killcare? Fortunately, and with the help of both Adam Crouch and Liesl Tesch, Transport NSW has arranged a free shuttle ferry between Wagstaffe and Ettalong meeting up with a free shuttle bus between Ettalong and Patonga. It might add 45 mins to your journey, but you can make it. Ditto for travellers coming our way for day trips or to stay.

For us, the shuttle ferry operates in peak periods during weekdays and all day during weekends. You can find the timetable on the Fantasea website, along with times for Patonga – Palm Beach. We'll need to show that it is used, otherwise we'll lose it.

There is nothing definitive yet announced for dredging. Best case is the ferry may resume in September, worst case November / December. This is farcical and should never have happened.

On a completely different topic, you may have seen the concept for a Men's Shed to be sited in the back area of Turo Park. This was very well meaning of the proponents in their quest to find a home but is subject to all sorts of difficulties in permission to use the site as well as concerns of neighbours. This group are well funded and well resourced for equipment but have nowhere to go at present – other sites being knocked back by neighbours as well. In fact "Men's Shed" is probably a bit of a misnomer since many ladies in the area would also like to be part of the activities and skills development etc on offer. This indeed is the intention as we understand it. So, please help them find a site for a "Community Shed" so that everyone may benefit. The same plea applies to the proponents of the Community Garden who were working with the shed group to get site permission and governance arrangements in place to operate.

Lastly, by the time you read this, the comment period for the proposed telecoms tower on Wards Hill Road will have closed. For those commenting either way, it is fair to say that the DA determination will not be based on a popularity contest. We trust that the assessors will ignore some of the more outlandish claims submitted and rather focus on the merits of the proposal for community safety and amenity as voiced by many, along with technical compliance asserted by the proponents. Given past experience, there could still be further challenges if the determination is in favour of the proposal. We hope for the sake of the community that it will all resolve in favour of improved mobile service. Mike Allsop




