QUEEN JEAN OF WAGSTAFFE



Jean Jackson celebrates her 100th birthday on 28th November 2023. She's the kind of person who people think," If I live to be 100, I hope my life is like hers". She keeps strong connections with family, friends and community even though she is legally blind.

She served with the WAAF in World War 2. On Anzac Day this year, Jean was invited to be in the lead jeep of the parade by the Ipswich RSL. She was honoured to lay a wreath on the cenotaph. Later, she was asked to go on a private tour of the Amberley Military Base (Queensland), her place of service.

Her interests are varied. She stays fit with Pilates, she listens to 'talking books', and she is a talented gardener sharing flowers, knowledge and cuttings. Jean is an active elder at the Hardys Bay Community Church. She has strong ethics and values (she would say this herself). But she is also curious and open and genuinely interested in others' points of view.

RALPH (RAFAEL) PODOLSKI: 96-years-old! Polish! Inspirational! Local Artist!

A finalist in the Archibald Prize and other competitions Ralph retains a marvellous, large collection of works at Killcare Heights. As a very young teenager, Ralph fought with the resistance in Poland during WW2 and was

interned in a number of concentration camps. He survived and in 1946-47, he received a scholarship to study at the Academie Royal Des Beaux-Art de Brussels where he won a commendation medal for being first in his year. He still has it. Unable to finish his study because of the communist take-over of Poland he migrated to Australia in 1950. He completed his study at the Ontario College of Art and Design;

he achieved the highest academic results of any student up to that time. He returned to Australia in 1964. He is an extremely talented artist and a fascinating person with a rapier sharp memory. He has lived a long, extraordinary and unique life, so come to his exhibition at the Gosford Regional Gallery from Saturday, 13th January through to Sunday 25th February 2024 and experience his beautiful paintings.
