SCULPTURE SHOW at WAGSTAFFE

The Bouddi Society had been toying with the idea of a sculpture show at Wagstaffe for quite a while. The viability was checked via an 'Expression of Interest' email sent to sculptors on the Central Coast. With the positive responses received, the Society decided to proceed with the show and 'Sculpture at Wagstaffe' was born. With no prior knowledge of running a sculpture show, the Society drew on sculptor Colin Tapping's experience.

Over the weekend, up to 900 visitors explored the works of 29 sculptors celebrating the diversity and artistry that make our Central Coast community so special.

The keynote opening speaker was Gabrielle Paananen from MacMasters Beach. A Bouddi Foundation for the Arts grant helped to set her on an ambitious path to obtain outstanding artistic skills in many fields. More below.

The show was an amazing success, above what anyone had hoped for. With sales of \$24,500, the Society made \$8,100. Apart from the financial success, the show was also, and perhaps more importantly, a great community event.

The Bouddi Society would like to thank everyone who participated and contributed to the spirit of 'Sculpture at Wagstaffe'.

LOCAL TALENT at the SHOW

We were honoured to welcome Gabrielle Paananen – a visionary young sculptor, puppeteer, creature designer, taxidermist, and illustrator – as our keynote opening speaker. Gab captivated the gathering with the extraordinary journey that has defined a nascent artistic

career with an evolving focus on the movement of creatures. Here is her entry into our show.

Receiving a Bouddi Foundation for the Arts grant at just 17 years old, she set out on an ambitious path -- from studying taxidermy in Oregon, USA, rescuing local wildlife, breathing life into a 6.5-metre moving puppet for Vivid Sydney, undertaking a residency in Finland, learning metal welding, and now preparing for an artist residency later this year in Japan. Gab is a wonderful young artist with an a amazing future.

President's Notes

As noted in the last issue, with effect from July 1st, the Hardys Bay Residents Group has amalgamated with WTKCA. This gives our local community a common voice on matters relating to planning, infrastructure and services in our area, along with support for other groups with their own diverse interests. The WTKCA committee has been expanded and we are pleased to be joined by 4 new committee members previously leading the HBRG committee. HBRG as an entity is now being wound up and its assets and liabilities transferred to WTKCA.

One issue generating strong community concern is coming to a head this month. The proposal for improved mobile communications through the provision of a tower on council land off Wards Hill Rd is to be heard by the Land and Environment Court. Anyone who had sent a submission to the most recent DA on this matter would have received a letter advising that the Court will meet on site at 10.30 on July 14, with any alteration in venue to be advised (eg due to weather etc). This is open to the public, so please attend if this is important to you at 37 Wards Hill Rd, at the water tank. It is our view that there is no viable 'Plan B'. Any alternatives would have more limitations on coverage or carriers serviced or even the type of handset required. This proposal can proceed forthwith on approval, while any rejection or reconsideration will put us back several years, if ever, for a solution meeting obvious safety, convenience and business demands.

Submissions relating the revised proposal for development of the large commercial lot closed on June 16.

While this was put forward as an amendment to a prior approved DA, the bulk of the development seems to have progressively increased ever since the first proposal in 2009. We hope the planners review this in conjunction with various community submissions and constrain it to the previously approved form.

Our next WTKCA Community Meeting will be July 14 at 7:30pm at Wagstaffe Hall. We are pleased that Mayor Laurie McKinna (one of our Ward Councilors) will be our guest speaker.

Please join us if you are able.
