President's Notes October 2025

We note that as late spring and summer approaches we are seeing a strong demand for functions at Wagstaffe Hall. This is great to see and pleasing that the community is choosing to celebrate locally. Not only does the Hall benefit, but also events at the Hardys Bay Club, the Killcare SLSC and our local commercial venues are seeing equal demand.

One of the consequences of the popularity of Wagstaffe Hall (with its new kitchen and interior paint scheme I might add), is that we have had to postpone the annual Book Fair, usually held in late October. This has been locked in for 2026, so we apologise if you have boxes of books waiting. If you do not have any local alternative for disposal of good quality books, we could recommend the Lifeline Book Depot at West Lindfield who would be happy to accept them.

Continuing on matters relating to Wagstaffe Hall, we are presently looking at the potential to add a battery to our existing solar panel system so that all the good energy generated during the day but unused could be harnessed for evening functions to avoid peak power bills. In our case, we would need Council approval to proceed with any proposal we settle on, so it is not a foregone conclusion as yet despite what the maths might say. We will keep the community informed as to how we get on, but in the meantime we would recommend having a chat locally to the Electrify Bouddi group if you are considering a similar upgrade at your home. They are a great source of advice.

All the studios are designated with a red flag to let visitors know they're open for business.
