There will be a further on-site hearing of the Land and Environment Court on December 8 at 10:30am. The Hardys Bay (+) Foreshore Masterplan is progressing through Council at present and will be published online for community comment probably late January. We will reach out to the community when it is available and encourage your feedback. The general sense at the moment is to please just get on with it—especially priority items like roads and foreshore edge stabilization.

A quick point for parents to help please. There has been significant damage to the fence at Turo Park Tennis Court with kids cutting the wire and coming onto the court to kick balls and in one instance to race electric scooters. Not only is this most disrespectful, but fence and court surface repairs are very costly. The community pays, not Council.

Stephen Hinks is retiring as the long serving pastor of Hardys Bay Community Church. Stephen commenced his role in June 2013. He and his wife Anne have been active, not only in the church, but also the wider community. He concludes his role as pastor on Christmas Day this year.

Stephen is well known in this community. He is a member of our fire brigade. He also served as the initial president of Killy Cares. Stephen is chaplain of the Killcare Surf Club and a chaplain supporting people through Disaster Recovery in NSW. He commenced the highly regarded Easter Art Show which is held at the church each year. Stephen has also been involved regularly in the Anzac Day ceremonies held at Hardys Bay Club. Each year he arranges for the church to participate in Clean Up Australia.

Anne is also an active and highly valued member of the local community. She has successfully led many women's ministries through the church.

Stephen is retiring after more than 50 years in various roles in Christian Education and churches. Here's something to do on the last Saturday afternoon in the months to come Come and see a film at Wagstaffe Hall

Martin Sieper and Jeremy Linton-Mann have joined forces as the Wagstaffe Documentary Appreciation Group (WAG-DAGs) to bring an inaugural summer season of documentary programs to Wagstaffe Hall. Screenings are to be held monthly beginning with a locally produced documentary focus on the golden Australian aviation era of the flying boats, from early days of pilots in open cockpits with leather helmets and goggles, to the RAAF flying boat squadrons of WW2, and completing the story with the end of the Lord Howe Island Ansett service in 1974. 'From Sea to Sky' will have been screened on Saturday October 25th between 3 and 5pm. The following month's documentary screening on November 29th will be local filmmaker Bill Young's documentary 'A Very Short War', a production about a WW2

pilot and war hero, Cliff Carpenter, who gave his life fighting for his country.
