SCULPTURE AT WAGSTAFFE

JUNE LONG WEEKEND

Saturday 6 - Sunday 7 June 2026

9 am - 4 pm

The Bouddi Society is thrilled to once again host the Bouddi Sculpture Show - a celebration of creativity and talent from sculptors across the Central Coast! There are 23 sculptors exhibiting, and each artist will showcase up to three pieces. In total, there will be 60 sculptures on display offering an inspiring variety of styles and materials, including wood, metal, ceramics, glass, and found objects. This is an exceptional opportunity to experience the diversity and richness of contemporary sculpture. Among the many well-known sculptors featured are Gab Paananen, Piers Jones, Simon Treseder, John Woulfe and Colin Tapping. Sculptures will be for sale, with prices ranging from \$95 to \$7,500. Proceeds will support the Bouddi Foundation for the Arts, providing vital grants to emerging young artists on the Central Coast. All are welcome to the official opening of the Show at 3pm on Saturday June 6 when there will be the opportunity to meet the exhibiting sculptors.



President's Notes – Mike Allsop

Moving into winter and more southerly swell, it is timely that dredging operations have resumed in the Ettalong Channel to enable ferry services and deeper keeled vessels to operate safely. The sudden diversion of the Fantasea ferries to Patonga was the result of rapid shoaling of the sand bars of Lobster Beach and Half Tide Rocks due to recent swells. This diversion of the Palm Beach service will stay until dredging is complete – likely early June depending on the weather. In the meantime, the Dept of Transport is providing a free shuttle ferry between Wagstaffe and Ettalong meeting a free shuttle bus to Patonga. Use it while you can, although add an extra hour door to door for your journey.

The Draft Foreshore Masterplan consultation was successful, and Council will be publishing a summary on their website soon. No changes of any significance are anticipated, so the final version should be adopted by Council shortly afterwards. Detail planning, budgeting and funding effort can then be scheduled for individual scopes of work over time. In parallel, it has been good to see road works re-building Pretty Beach Road and Araluen Drive along the foreshore, consistent with recommendations in the masterplan. There is much more to do, but we are seeing positive results so far.

Other bugbears which were highlighted by the community consultation program were the scattering of "dead" unseaworthy and unused watercraft overgrown with weeds around the foreshore, and the continual storage by absent owners of trailers and boats in prominent areas next to parkland. Council is now looking to take action on both these matters, especially the removal of derelict items. Trailers etc are likely to be subject to parking restrictions by Council, subject to further review of options. We are looking for a firm result on this, as well as responsible reactions from the absent owners.

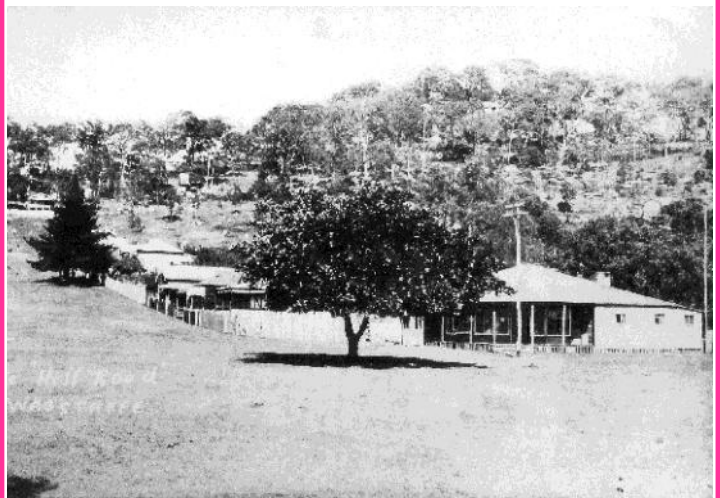
