Our first, new season film *THE BAULKHAM HILLS AFRICAN LADIES TROUPE* is a celebration of the remarkable spirit of four African women – survivors of sexual abuse – and the triumph of their improbable theatre troupe. Four refugee women, from different parts of Africa, fled to Australia in order to escape violence and abuse. Finding safe haven in Australia was but part of their journey, as they still held their pain silently within – until they decided to join a theatre group, and speak out.

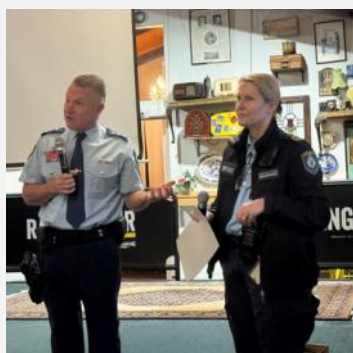
Wildflower Walk

President's Notes – Mike Allsop

As we noted last month, WTKCA responded to community concern over various incidents of theft and vandalism by calling a public meeting to be addressed by NSW Police Community Liaison. This was held at the Hardys Bay Club on 12 August and addressed by two senior officers from Brisbane Water Command. The community response was huge, with about 150 people attending the standing room only event. Various summaries have been distributed locally by email to WTKCA members and to the local FB page. In all, some assurance was given that we are not seeing a particularly heightened level of risk and that in most cases the offenders were soon apprehended. The majority of thefts were of car keys from unlocked premises. Furthermore, if events are not reported, the Police cannot do anything about it. Some useful mitigation measures were discussed, including low cost self-contained CCTV systems which are very helpful to Police in tracking down offenders. Keeping premises and vehicles locked was also an obvious piece of advice.



Triple Zero (000) for emergencies or life threatening situations. Immediate assistance required.

Police Assistance Line 131 444 for non-emergencies (e.g. reporting after the event, incident number for insurance etc.).

Crime Stoppers 1800 333 000 to provide information anonymously. (e.g. suspicious activity).

Don't try to ring the Police Station itself – often too busy to answer.

We thank NSW Police for joining us in this session, as well as our local MP Adam Crouch and two of our Ward Councilors, Jared Wright and Sharon Walsh. Special thanks to the Hardys Bay Club for opening specially for us.

Mark Your Calendar for the Bouddi Peninsula Arts Trail

The October long weekend (3rd and 4th) is nestled right in the middle of spring holidays and so is the annual **Bouddi Peninsula Art Trail**. This event has become a staple for visitors to the Central Coast. This year 24 local artists from Killcare Heights through to Wagstaffe, NSW open their art studios, workshops and homes to the art curious. Four new artists join the trail this year, including an urban sketcher, large-scale nature photographer, a photo-media artist, and a textile and print artist.



The annual Bouddi Peninsula Arts Trail is a unique way to meet these accomplished artists. See how artists create their diverse works by stepping into an artist's studio. It's an opportunity to chat with them about what inspires them. And for many, the inspiration is right there in the Bouddi National Park with its tranquil bays, surf, beaches, park trails and stunning flora and fauna.

Meander from Killcare Heights and Killcare, down to Hardy's Bay, around the bend to Pretty Beach and Wagstaffe and find works including watercolour, oil and acrylic painting, photography, ceramics, printmaking, mixed media, sculpture, and drawings.

Armed with a Bouddi Peninsula Arts Trail map, locate open studios displaying a red flag. Plan a day or two visiting the studios and recharge at local cafes, restaurants and shops.

Specific details about the artists, their work, and the trail can be found on the Bouddi Peninsula Arts Trail website, Instagram or Facebook. Brochures will also be available in local businesses and at each studio.

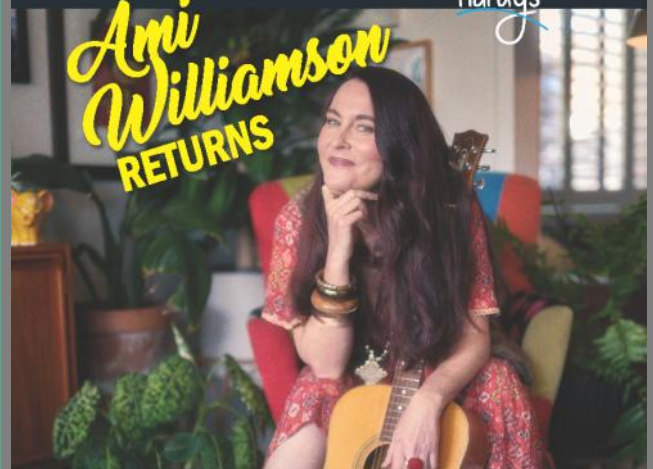
